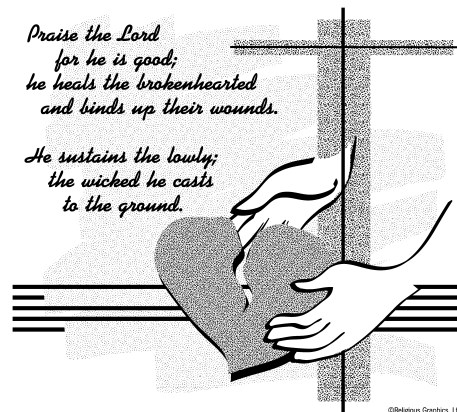

Rape and incest are almost always given as justification for abortion. **The truth is, abortion due to rape and incest represent only about 1% of all abortions.**
